V. DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT: The Police Chief Mike Kemp reported on the activities of the department. Kemp stated that the department hosted a 3-day training class at the community center that 18 officers from neighboring communities attended.

PUBLIC WORKS MANAGER'S REPORT: The Public Works Manager Mike Schopp reported on the activities of the department. Water loss was up this month due to water leaks found and a house fire. The loss should be less next month. Hydrant flushing in the Village started today and should be done within a day or two. The department changed the fire hydrant at 303 Madison St.

Fencing for entrance of sewer lagoon – Schopp presented a quote from Hohulin Fence Company to install a 40-foot double swinging entrance gate and 515-feet of 6foot fencing to connect to the existing fencing at the sewer lagoon. The cost will be \$34,155.67. Hohulin Fence Company is the only company in the area that can do this type of fencing.

Trustee Peterson moved, seconded by Trustee Haynes to authorize Hohulin Fence Company to do fencing project for the entrance of the sewer lagoons at a cost not to exceed \$35,000. On a roll call, the vote was:
