EMA COORDINATOR'S REPORT: EMA Coordinator Bob Davies reported on the activities of the department. The department is nearly done upgrading all the radios for the department. The department has had 26 weather related call you so far this year. Davies continues to update the one call one system and the disabled community list.

POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT: Police Chief Kemp reported on the activities of the department. Winter coats have been ordered for the crossing guards. Kemp is getting quotes on a new handheld radar unit for the department.

Hire additional full-time officer – At this time applications are being taken for the position.

Schmidgall felt that this is something the community should be aware of and approved an informative flyer to be mailed out to the community regarding the Safe-T-Act. The act will eliminate cash bail for a category of crimes and make it that certain crimes cannot be detained pretrial. More information can be found in the Illinois State Status 725ILCS 5/110-6.1 and 725ILCS 5/5-5-3.
