A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE CORPORATE PURPOSES OF THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS

FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF MAY 1, 2023 THROUGH APRIL 20, 2024

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MACKINAW, TAZEWELL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1:

Ordinance No. 1044, which was An Ordinance Making Budgets And Appropriations For The Corporate Purposes Of The Village Of Mackinaw, Illinois For The Fiscal Year of May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024 is hereby amended by interlineation in the following manner:

- 1. On page 6, the total appropriation for the school crossing guard purposes is changed by interlineation from "\$5,000.00" to "\$5,200.00".
- 2. On page 10, the total amount appropriated for Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund Purposes is hereby changed by interlineation from "\$45,000.00" to "\$70,000.00".
- 3. The total amount appropriated herein in is changed by interlineation from "\$5,105,800 to \$5,131,000.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Except as modified by this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 1044 of the Village of Mackinaw shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: If any section, subdivision or sentence of this ordinance is held invalid, it shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: A certified copy of this Supplemental Budget and Appropriation Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk of Tazewell County by the Village Clerk within 30 days after the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.
